The GFWC/Iowa Federation of Women's Clubs is the proud sponsor of a scholarship program that is unique to the state of Iowa. Each year, thousands of dollars are given to graduating Iowa High School seniors who will attend Iowa post-secondary schools. Scholarship awards are based on volunteerism, achievement, and financial need. Both male and female students are eligible.

Our list of scholarships for 2025 is enclosed. High school students may apply for more than one scholarship but are only eligible to receive one. They must fill out a separate application for each scholarship; however, they may use the same letters of recommendation.

Attached please find the application form for interested seniors. After the application has been emailed to the Scholarship Chairman, the student will receive a phone call from a GFWC club member so that they may interview the student and write an additional letter of recommendation. This also ensures that all applications are complete prior to the **February 1, 2025, email deadline**.

GFWC/Iowa Scholarship Information Sheet Application Deadline- February 1, 2025

The GFWC/Iowa Scholarship Committee administers several scholarships to Iowa students in Iowa colleges and universities. This money is paid to the student by check, after she/he has provided registration documentation to the GFWC/Iowa State Headquarters for the fall term in the year the scholarship is awarded. The number of each scholarship awarded is determined by the amount of money contributed by clubs, proceeds from special fund-raising projects and interest from investments on memorial scholarships. GFWC/Iowa scholarship awards are based on volunteerism, achievement, and financial need.

GFWC/Iowa Scholarships 2025

1.	E. Lucille Miller Memorial Music Scholarship (College Undergraduate)	\$1,000	Open to a graduating high school senior majoring in Music at an accredited four-year Iowa college or university.
2.	GFWC/Iowa Scholarship (College Undergraduate) (Multiple to be Awarded)	\$1,000	Open to a graduating high school senior enrolled in Undergraduate studies attending an accredited four-year Iowa college or university.
3.	Community College Scholarship (Multiple to be Awarded)	\$500	Open to a graduating high school senior enrolled in a 2-year accredited Iowa community college/technical school or other comparable accreditation/certification program.



Directions for Student Applicants

Dear Student:

Applicants should fill out all necessary documents, collect all necessary materials, organize them in order of the checklist found on the second page of the application, and email ALL pages of the scholarship application and required information to the State Chairman as written on the checklist page of the scholarship application.

You may apply for more than one scholarship; however, you are only eligible to receive one. You must fill out a separate application form for each scholarship but may use the same letters of recommendation.

A one-page essay "How my involvement in my community has impacted my life," should include any special circumstances that would make the scholarship beneficial for you.

GFWC/Iowa scholarship awards are based on volunteerism, achievement, and financial need, in that order. All information is confidential.

Please remember that a late or incomplete application will be rejected. CHECK ALL MATERIAL CAREFULLY. <u>February 1, 2025, is the Email DEADLINE</u>. *Students will receive judging results via email after March 15th*.
